




Connecting high level political support to real change

- Political support: Part of Sendai Framework implementation; Early Warnings for All Action and Ocean Decade; 20th anniversary of Indian Ocean tsunami events
- Mobilizing communities: #GetToHighGround activations, Tsunami United project engaging 60 schools, High School Students Summit
- National and local action: new or revised strategies on tsunami risk, updated evacuation routes, new tsunami warning sensors and warning systems installed
- Media coverage: Asia Broadcasting Union
- Partnership: UNESCO IOC, other UN entities and beyond
- Digital advocacy: Social media strategy







#GetToHighGround campaign mobilizing action

- #GetToHighGround with UNESCO IOC public facing campaign engaging people to run/walk tsunami evacuation routes. Focus on inclusion and leave no one behind
- Since 2022, events in Indonesia, Seychelles, Tonga, Cook Islands, Barbados, Fiji, Mauritius, Portugal, Samoa, Ecuador, and more.
- Boosts implementation: new/revised strategies on DRR/tsunami risk, updated evacuation routes, new tsunami warning sensors and warning systems installed







WTAD 2024: 20th commemoration Indian Ocean Tsunami












- Art Exhibition "Tsunami: Sea Change for Resilience" (Geneva, Paris, Manila, New York, Sendai)
- #GetToHighGround activation: issuing joint invitation call to the Member States and coorganizing the campaign activations, in 2024 in Banda Aceh, Indonesia with UNESCO-IOC Global Tsunami Symposium: Reflection of the Two Decades of the Indian Ocean Tsunami 2004
- Tsunami United Project: series of educational webinars on tsunami and DRR resilience for youth and children in the region of the Indian Ocean, engaging 19 countries, 59 schools, 439 students, teachers and administrators
- High School Students Summit in Japan's Kumamoto prefecture on 23-24 October with 526 students
- Social media, website, customizable cards and 6 tsunami videos – reach 1 million

- Stop Disasters! online game teaches children about disasters, including tsunami risk
- The new DRR Scout Badge includes
 tsunami risk and educates children and young people on disasters
