


Why Do Stakeholder Mapping?





- 1. Identify All Relevant Stakeholders
- 2. Understand Stakeholder Influence and Interest

Mapping shows who has power, who is most affected, and who needs to be kept informed or actively engaged.

- 3. Prioritize Communication and Engagement
- 4. Manage Expectations and Risks

Understanding stakeholders' expectations early helps avoid conflicts and resistance later in the project.

5. Improve Decision-Making

Knowing who to consult for decisions or approvals streamlines governance and accountability.

6. Build Support and Buy-In.






