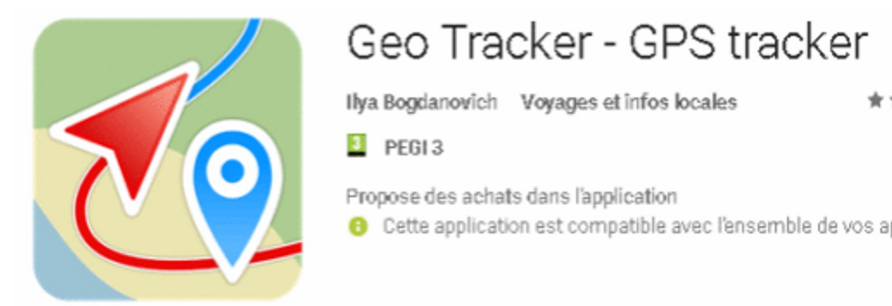

1.- Let's locate ourselves

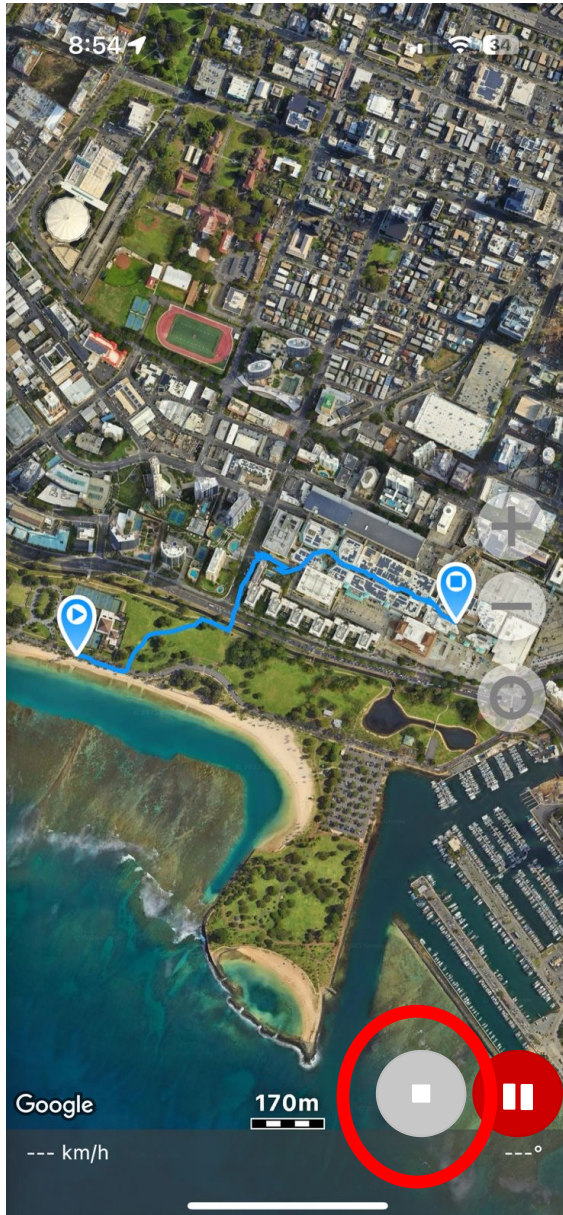
2.- Press REC

We will gather at our meeting point.

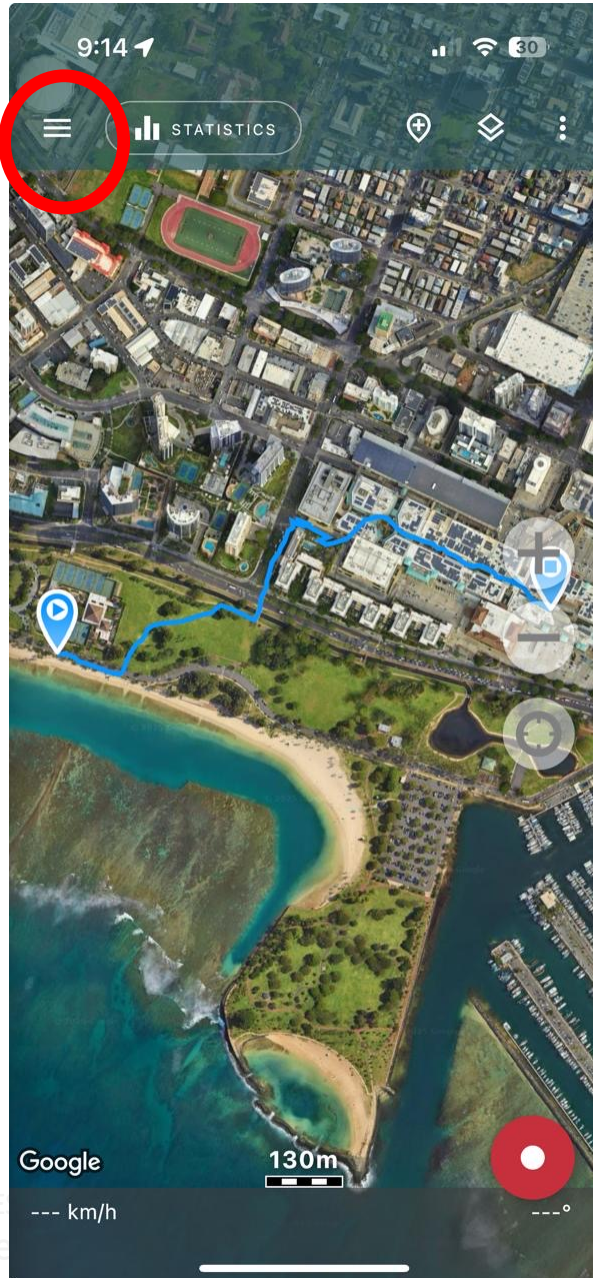


3. Stop the recording.

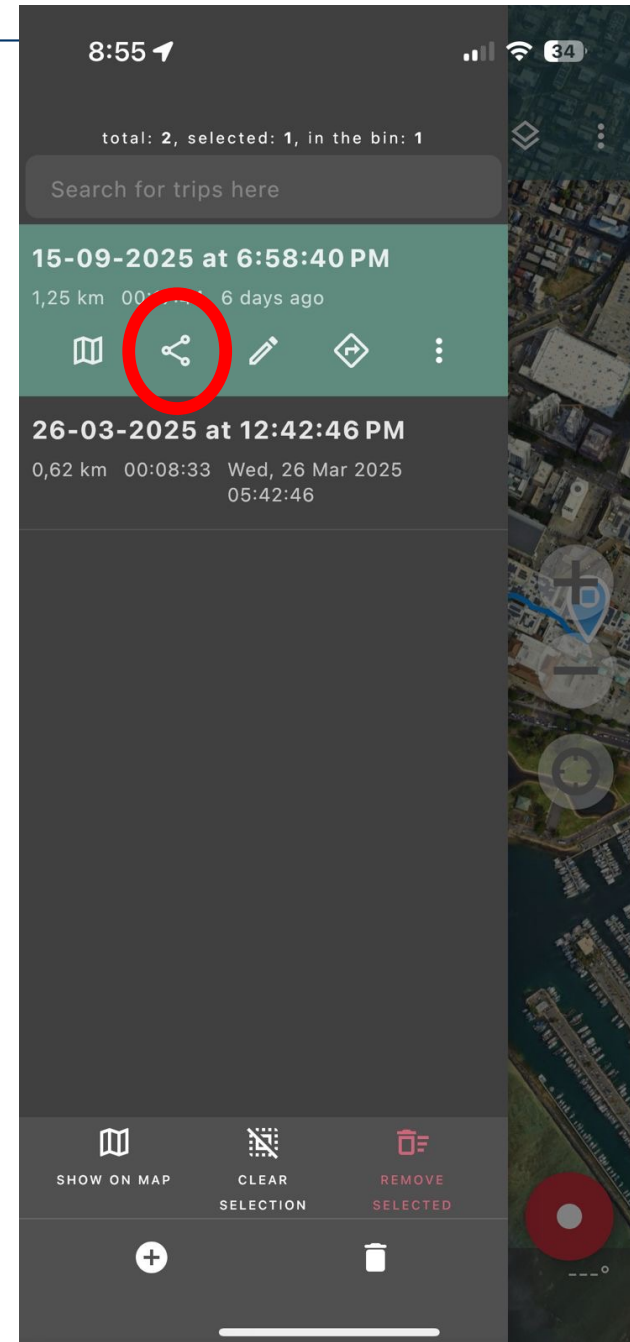


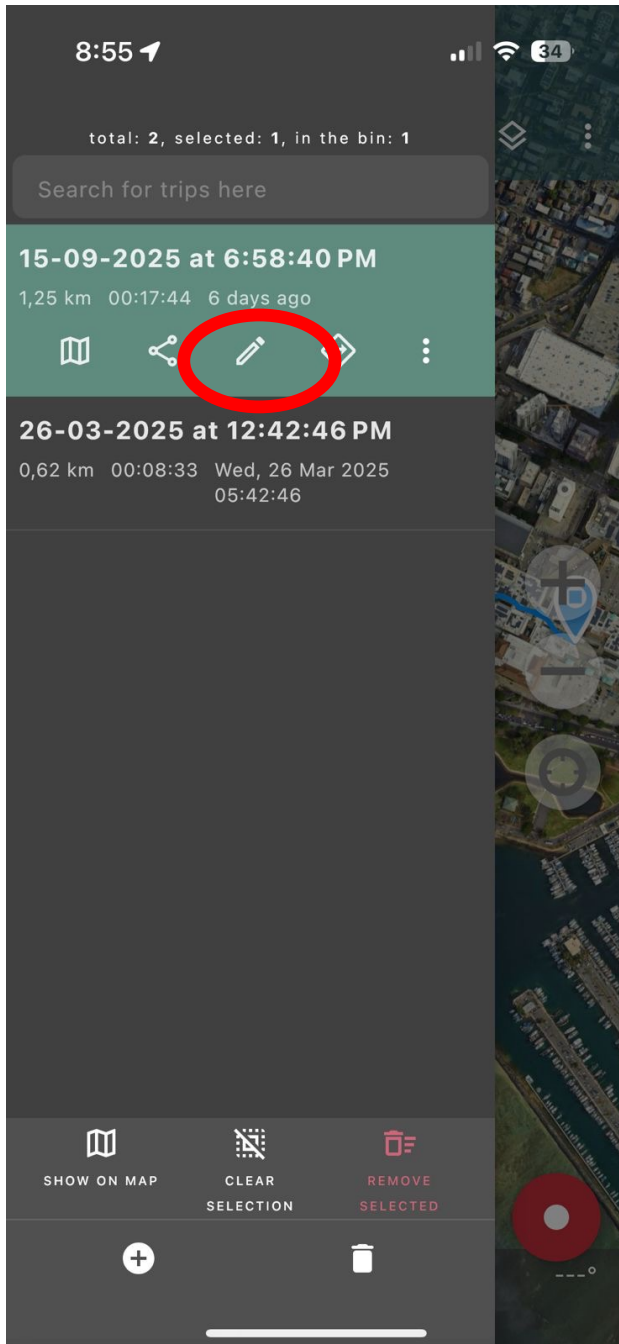
# When the recording ends...

4. Press the top left corner.

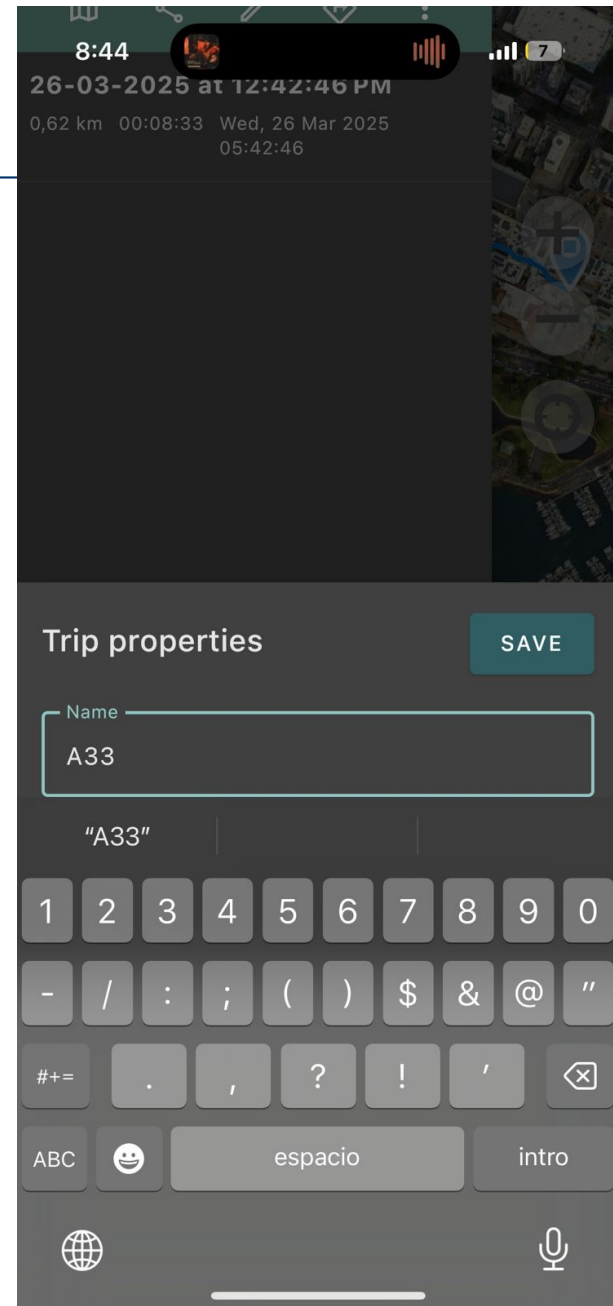


5. Press the SHARE option.



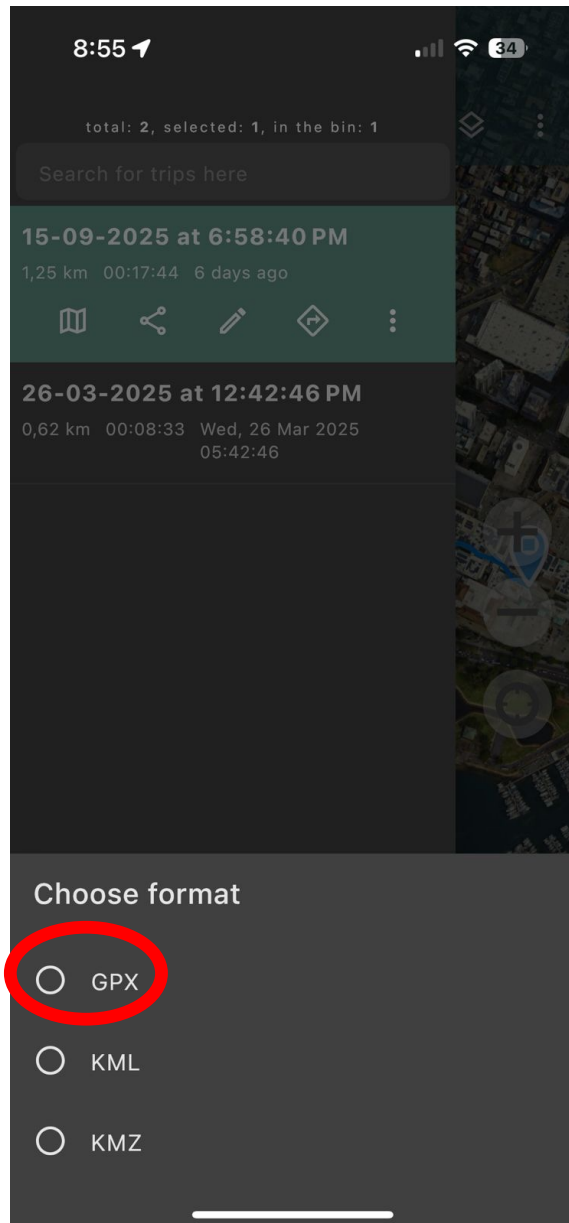

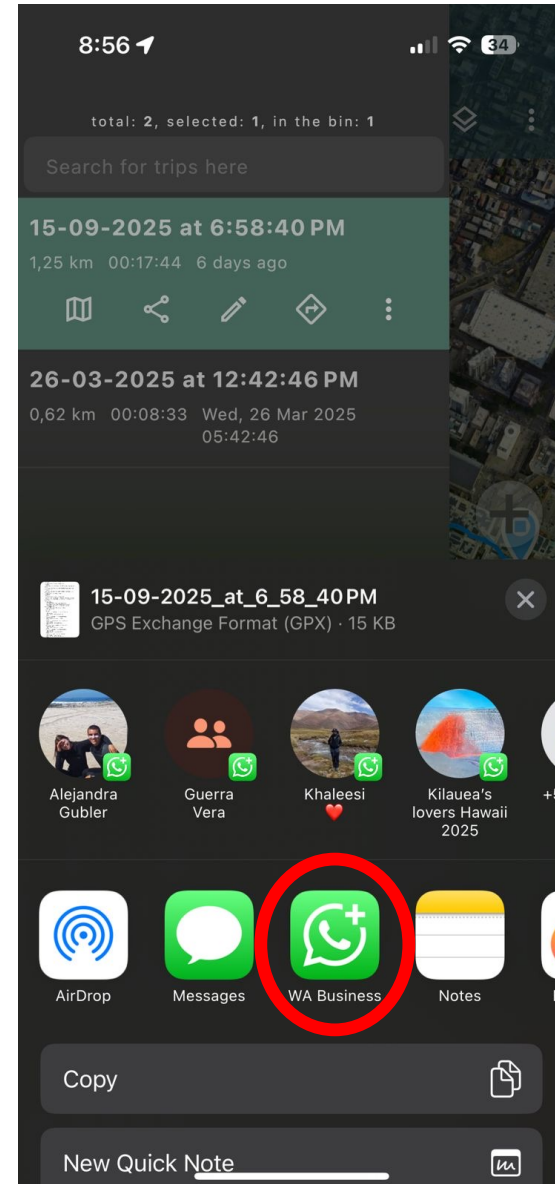
